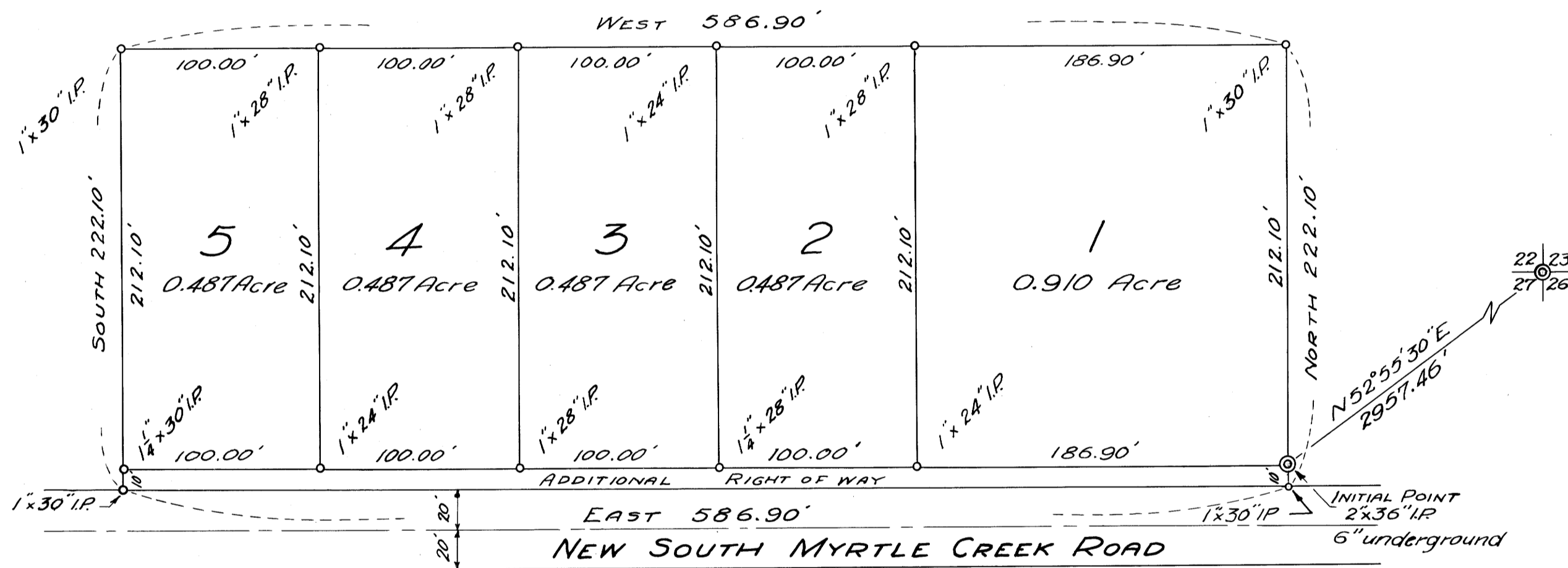
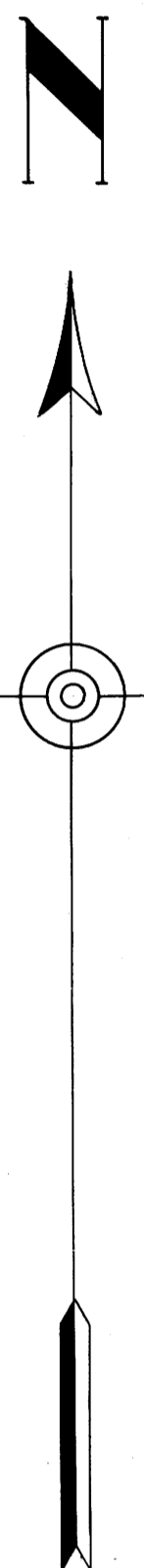

CERTIFICATE OF SURVEYOR

I, Edwin S. Woodford, being first duly sworn depose and say that I have surveyed and marked with proper monuments the lands shown on the annexed plat of which the following is a true and correct description.
Beginning at a 2-inch by 36-inch iron pipe from which the North east corner of Section 27 in Twp. 29S, R. 5W, W.M. bears N52°55'30"E 2957.46 feet; thence North 212.10 feet to a 1-inch by 30-inch iron pipe; thence West 586.90 feet to a 1-inch by 30-inch iron pipe; thence South 222.10 feet to a 1-inch by 30-inch iron pipe on the North right-of-way line of the New South Myrtle Creek Road; thence East along said right-of-way line 586.90 feet to a 1-inch by 30-inch iron pipe; thence North 10.00 feet to the place of beginning and containing 2.992 acres more or less.
