



SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, Alton E. Alspaugh, being first duly sworn depose and say that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments the lands shown on the annexed plot of which the following is a true and correct description.

Beginning at a 2" x 36" inch iron pipe set for an initial point in accordance with the laws of the State of Oregon from which the Section Corner common to Sections 5, 6, 7, and 8 Township 30 South, Range 5 West of the Willamette Meridian, Douglas County, Oregon bears N 32° 20' E 1638.2 feet; thence S 0° 02' W 997.4 feet to a 1" iron pipe that intersects present Pacific Highway right-a-way line; thence S 23° 48' W 50.0 feet to a 2" iron pipe; thence N 63° 17' W 1013.5 feet to a 1" inch iron pipe; thence S 23° 25' W 190.6 feet to a 1" inch iron pipe; thence S 17° 11' E 152.0 feet to a 1" inch iron pipe; thence S 26° 39' E 483.0 feet to a 1" inch iron pipe; thence S 61° 39' E 540.5 feet to a 1" inch iron pipe, intersecting present Pacific Highway right-a-way line; thence S 23° 48' W 327.0 feet to a 1" iron pipe; thence N 89° 27' W 1,429.0 feet to a 2" soil pipe marking the Wm Weaver D.L.C. #39 Southwest Corner; thence N 0° 08' W 1,900.8 feet to a 1" inch iron pipe; thence S 89° 24' E 1,829.8 feet to the point of beginning and containing 63.85 acres more or less and all lying in the Wm Weaver D.L.C. #39 and in Section 7, Township 30 S, R5 W, W. M., Douglas County, Oregon.
