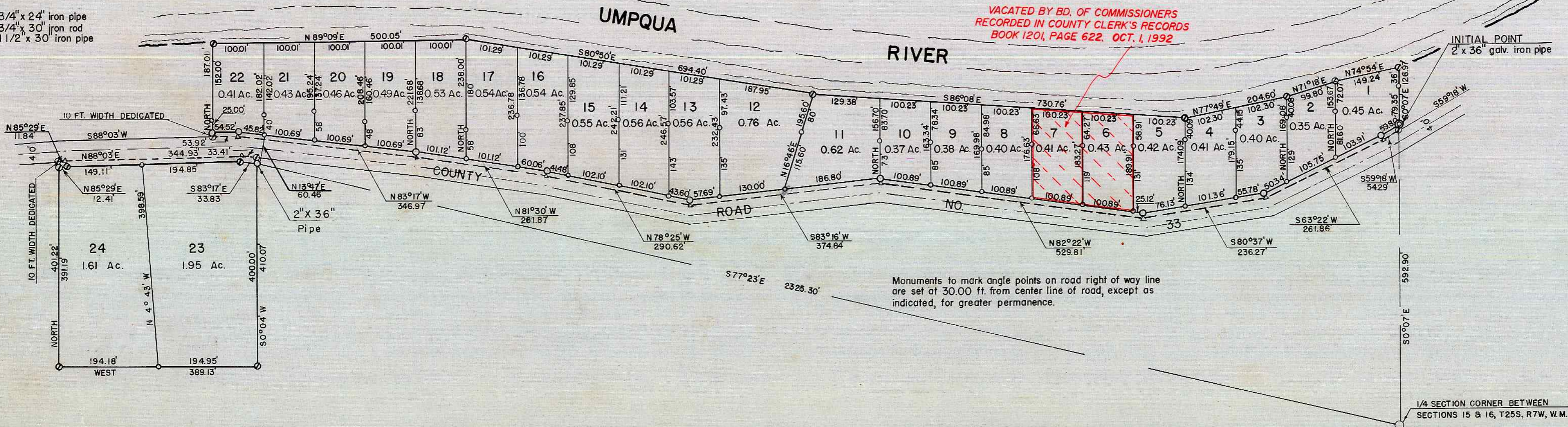


NOTE:

All lot lines not otherwise noted have a North-South bearing Pipes set back from river bank on lot lines are so placed for protection from wash and accessibility for marking the direction of lot lines.

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, PERCY C. ARMSTRONG, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments the land shown on the annexed plat of which the following is a true and correct description, to wit:

Beginning at the INITIAL POINT, a 2" x 36" galvanized iron pipe set 6" below the surface of the ground and from which the 1/4 Section Corner between Sections 15 and 16, T25S, R7W, W.M. in Douglas County, Oregon bears S0°07' E 592.90 ft., thence S0°07' E 1162 ft., thence S59°18' W 54.29 ft., thence S63°22' W 261.86 ft., thence S80°37' W 236.27 ft., thence N82°22' W 529.81 ft., thence S83°16' W 374.84 ft., thence N78°25' W 290.62 ft., thence N81°30' W 261.87 ft., thence N83°17' W 346.97 ft., thence S88°03' W 53.92 ft., thence North 187.01 ft. to the Umpqua River, thence down stream along said river N89°09' E 500.05 ft., thence S80°50' E 694.40 ft., thence S86°08' E 730.76 ft., thence N77°49' E 204.60 ft., thence N71°18' E 99.80 ft., thence N74°54' E 149.24 ft., thence S0°07' E 115.35 ft. to the place of beginning, containing 11.02 acres, more or less.
