SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, ARTHUR BOYER, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments the land shown on the annexed plat of which the following is a true and correct description, to wit: Beginning at the INITIAL POINT, a two inch galvanized iron pipe driven six inches below the surface of the ground, on the northerly line of County Road No. 115B and at the southeasterly corner of property recorded in County Clerk's Records of Deeds in Vol. 181, Pg. 446 said beginning point being N 47° 09' W 1745.9 ft. from the east quarter Section Corner of Section 25, T26S, R6W, W.M., Douglas County, Oregon, thence running along the easterly line of said recorded property N 42° 23' W 270.0 ft. to a one inch iron pipe and N 42° 23' W 86.0 ft. to a point on the left bank of the North Umpqua River, thence running along left bank of said river N 43° 52' E, 100.09 ft., N 60° 19' E 102.40 ft., N 45° 03' E 100.04 ft., N 56° 54' E 108.80 ft., N 47° 55' E 100.04 ft., and N 43° 21' E 100.64 ft., thence leaving said bank of river and running, along the westerly line of the Ralph Church property recorded in County Clerk's Records of Deeds in Vol. 192, Pg. 523, S 40° 08' E 85.0 ft. to a one inch iron pipe, and S 40° 08' E 280.0 ft. to a one inch iron pipe on the northerly line of a dedicated roadway, thence running S 49° 38' W 214.2 ft. along said roadway line to a one inch iron pipe, thence N 40° 22' W 10.0 ft. to a one inch iron pipe on the northerly line of aforesaid County Road, thence S 49° 38' W 379.5 ft. along said County Road line to the place of beginning. Above bearings are based on the northerly line of said County Road No. 115B being S 49° 38' W.
