SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, PERCY C. ARMSTRONG, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments the land shown on the annexed plat of which the following is a true and correct description, to wit: Beginning at a 2" x 36" galvanized iron pipe set 6" below the surface of the ground and from which the Southwest Corner of Section 36-T25S-R6W-W.M., in Douglas County, Oregon bears S88°57'W 773.0 ft., thence N11°29'W 490.14 ft., thence N73°56'E 186.40 ft., thence S32°53'E 50.63 ft. to a point on the westerly boundary of County Road No. 32, thence following said Road boundary S12°07'E 130.03 ft., S16°24'E 21.00 ft., S19°37'E 123.53 ft., S24°36'E 111.10 ft., S40°30'E 94.70 ft. and S55°35'E 87.50 ft., thence leaving the aforesaid Road boundary S89°33'W 363.40 ft. to the place of beginning, containing 2.80 acres, more or less.

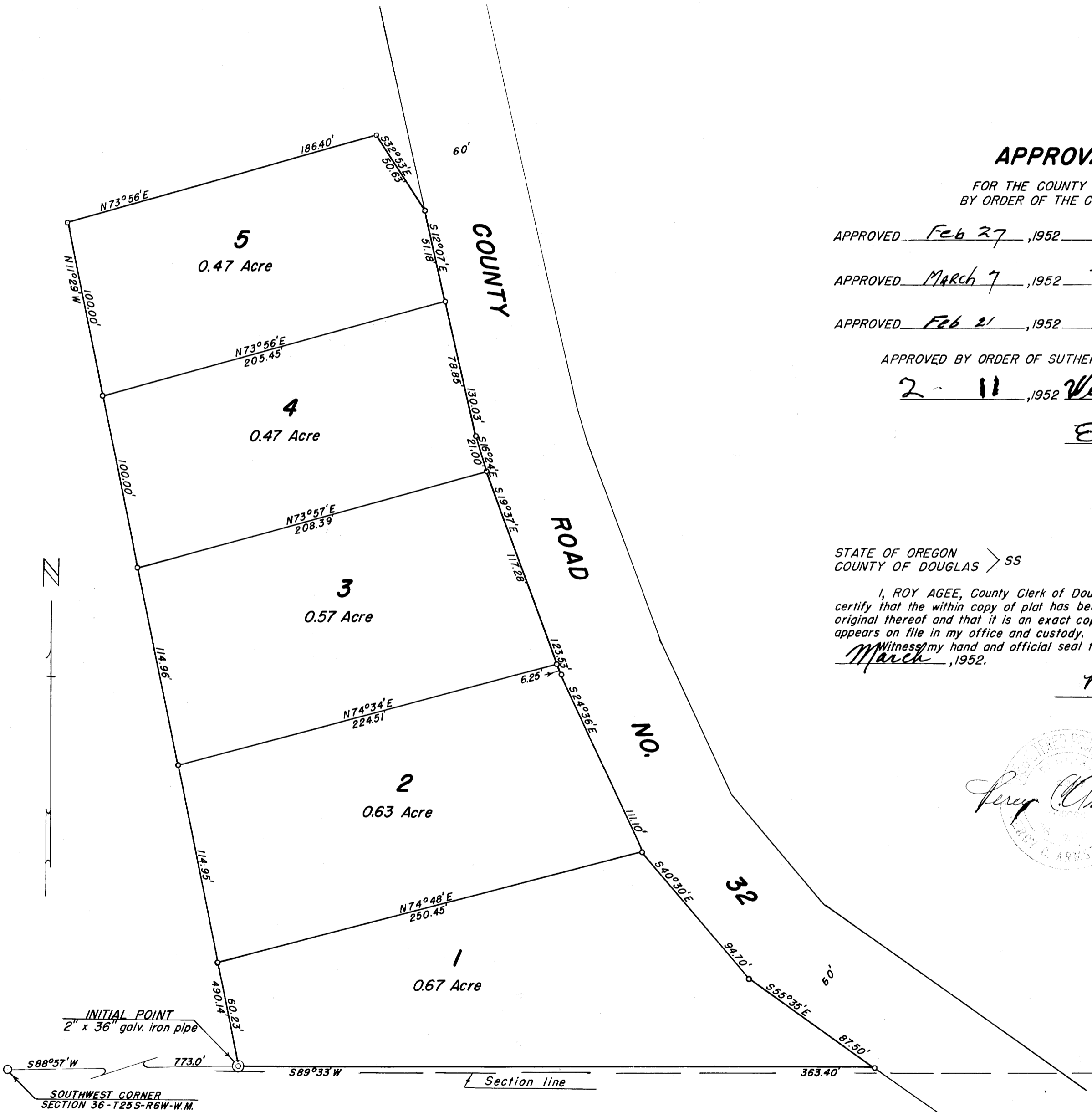
