SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, PERCY C. ARMSTRONG, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments the land shown on the annexed plat of which the following is a true and correct description, to wit:
 Beginning at the INITIAL POINT, a 2" x 36" galvanized iron pipe set 6" below the surface of the ground in the southerly boundary of "Amended Plat of Lots 1-B, Incl., Smith Acres at Lone Rock," a subdivision in Section 17, T26S, R3W, W.M., Douglas County, Oregon, from which the Southeast Corner of the J. H. French D. L. C. 40, T26S, R3W, W.M., bears N84°16'E 279.20 ft., N4°03'W 329.90 ft., and N42°08'E 975.83 ft., and also from which point a 1 1/2" iron pipe in the Southeast corner of Lot B of aforesaid subdivision and the Southwest corner of Lot 9 of "Smith Acres at Lone Rock" bears N84°16'E 279.20 ft., thence S1°23'W 291.75 ft. along the westerly boundary of a Douglas County property to a 3/4" iron rod at the Southwest corner of said property and the northwesterly boundary of County Road No. 4, thence S58°11'W 856.45 ft. along said northwesterly road boundary, thence leaving said road boundary N31°49'W 269.00 ft., thence N58°11'E 621.20 ft., thence N19°50'W 156.00 ft. to the Southwest corner of Lot 6 of "Amended Plat of Lots 1-B, Incl., Smith Acres at Lone Rock," thence N84°16'E 403.70 ft. along the southerly boundary of "Amended Plat of Lots 1-B, Incl., Smith Acres at Lone Rock" to the place of beginning, containing 6.42 acres more or less.
