



SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, ARTHUR BOYER, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments the land shown on the annexed plat of which the following is a true and correct description, to wit:
 All those certain parcels of land which comprise the east and west streets in the "MASONIC CEMETERY, Canyonville, Oregon" and the First Subdivision to the Masonic Cemetery, Canyonville, Oregon" which are made up of the spaces of ground which lie in said streets between the adjacent blocks to the north and south, excepting the east and west street on the extreme north side of said cemeteries and excepting the east and west street on the extreme south side of said cemeteries and also excepting the east and west street in the center of which is 160.0' North of the south line of said cemeteries, the three last mentioned streets are to remain open for traffic and the remaining streets are to be vacated as streets and transferred into lots and blocks as shown. ALSO: Four additional lots, each six and one-half feet in a northerly and southerly direction and eight feet in an easterly and westerly direction, two of which are on the south side of Block 42 and two on the north side of Block 43, as they exist and are shown on the annexed map. The Initial Monument of said "MASONIC CEMETERY, Canyonville, Oregon" bears N 44° 52' E 1665.4 ft. from the quarter section corner between sections 27 and 28, T30S, R5W, W.M., Douglas County, Oregon.
