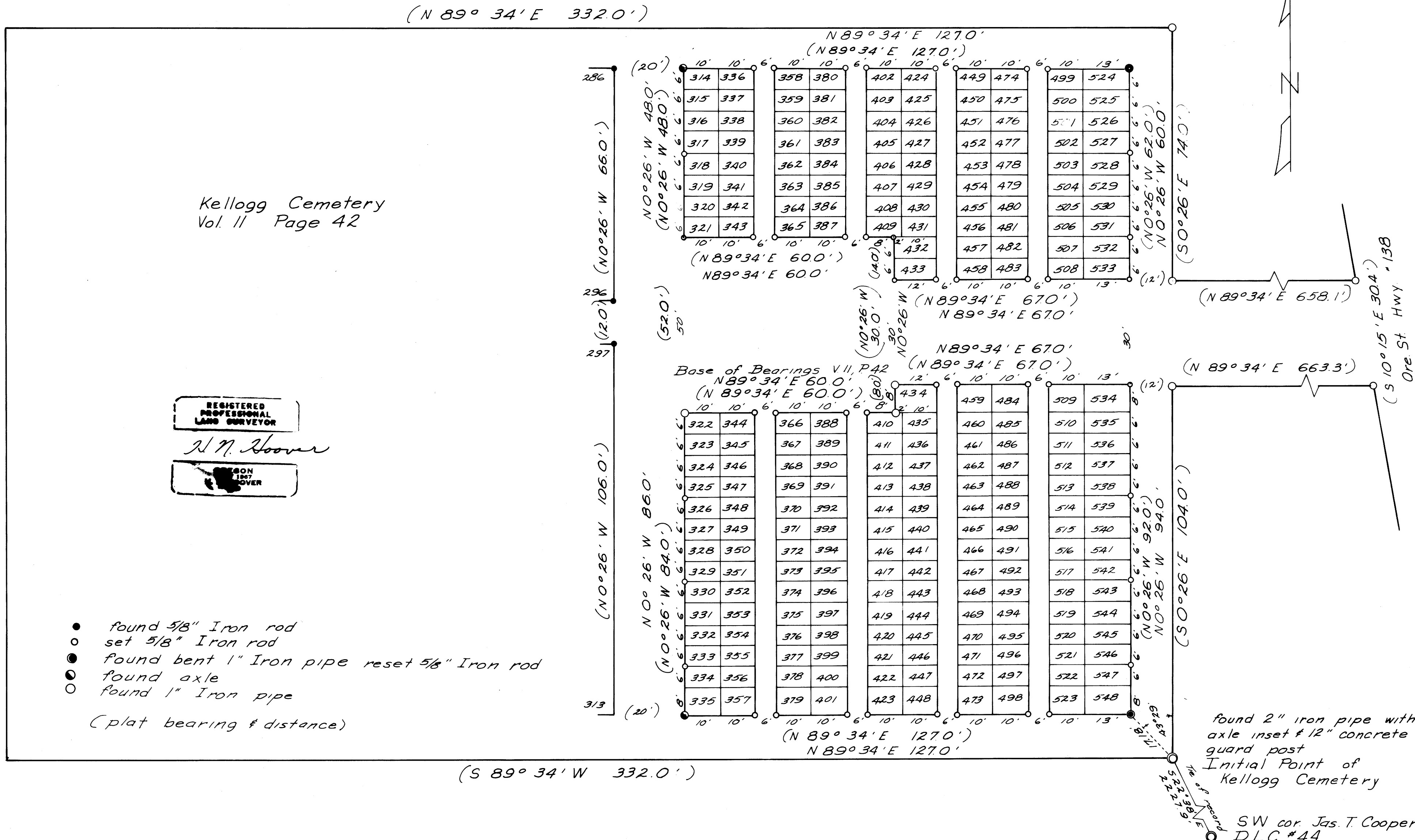


KELLOGG CEMETERY PLAT II

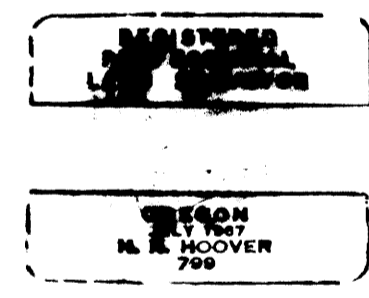
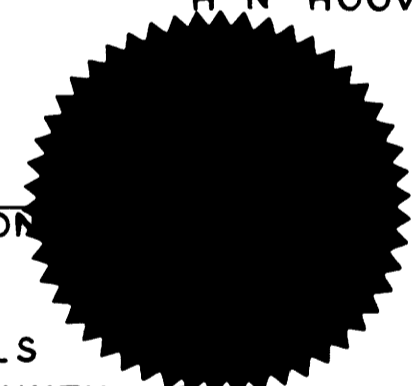
CERTIFICATE OF SURVEYOR
