Beginning at a 2" X 36" galvanized iron pipe driven 6 inches underground which is the initial point of Requiem Slopes being SOUTH 05° 44' 10" WEST 1220.97 feet from the N.W. corner Isaac Flint D.L.C. 45, T 30 S, R 6 W, W. M.; thence South 85° 49' 09" West 201.43 feet along the northerly line of the property recorded in Vol. 301, Pg. 78, Douglas County Deed Records, to a 5/8-inch iron rod; thence North 07° 46' 46" East 15.32 feet to a 5/8-inch iron rod; thence North 47° 31' 59" East 101.95 feet to a 5/8-inch iron rod; thence North 48° 24' 52" East 104.70 feet to a 5/8-inch iron rod; thence North 75° 47' 32" East 55.71 feet to a 5/8-inch iron rod; thence South 66° 32' 27" East 66.38 feet to a 5/8-inch iron rod; thence South 26° 17' 52" East 54.22 feet to a 5/8-inch iron rod; thence South 01° 09' 17" East 94.30 feet to a 5/8-inch iron rod; thence North 88° 19' 27" West 95.05 feet along the northerly line of Riddle Cemetery to the point of beginning, containing .78 acres more or less.
