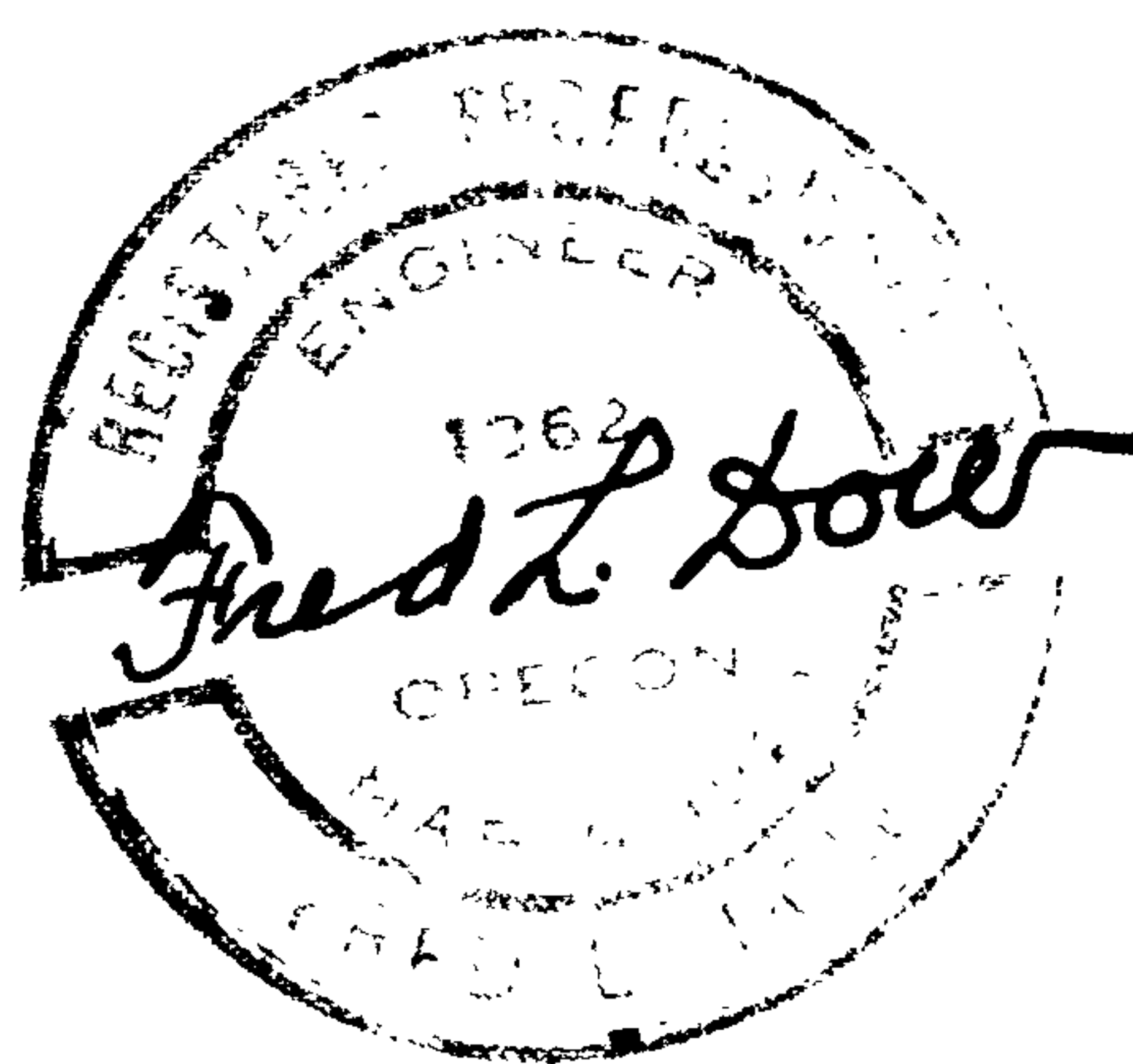


Beginning at an iron pipe on the Southeasterly Right of Way line of the Oregon State Highway from which the $\frac{1}{4}$ corner on the North line of Section 14, Township 22 South, Range 6 West, N.M. in Douglas County, Oregon bears North $66^{\circ}30'$ East 516.0 feet and running thence South $10^{\circ}50'$ East 73.7 feet to an iron pipe. Thence continuing South $10^{\circ}50'$ West 70.0 feet to a point in the center of Elk Creek. Thence downstream along the center of Elk Creek, South $18^{\circ}58'$ East 127.18 feet to a point. Thence leaving Elk Creek and running North $76^{\circ}13'$ West 100.0 feet to an iron pipe. Thence continuing North $76^{\circ}13'$ West 96.0 feet to an iron pipe on the said Southeasterly Right of Way line of the Oregon State Highway. Thence in a Northeasterly direction along the said Southeasterly Right of way line and on a curve to the right, 337.16 feet of which the long chord of said curve bears North $50^{\circ}19'$ East 336.17 feet to the place of beginning, containing 0.64 acres.
