DEDICATION.
Know All Men By These Presents that We, Maud B. Luse and J. F. Luse her husband, Annie M. Waite and F. B. Waite, her husband, all of Sutherlin, Oregon; The J. F. Luse Company, a corporation, organized and existing under and by virtue of the Laws of the State of Oregon, with its principal office at Sutherlin Oregon; Roach Timber Company, a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the Laws of the State of Iowa, with its principal office at Muscatine Iowa, the legal owners of the land through which the herein after described "State Street Extension" runs, hereby dedicate and devote to the use of the public forever for a public road, a strip of land sixty (60) feet in width, the center line of which is described as follows; to wit: Beginning at a stone monument in the center of State Street in the town of Sutherlin, from which the south-west corner of Block 39 of the Amended Plat of the townsite of Sutherlin, as surveyed, plotted and recorded in the office of the County Clerk of Douglas County, Oregon, bears N. 77° 04' E, a distance of 30.0 feet; thence S. 12° 56' E, 433.74 feet; thence S. 13° 04' E, 1593.9 ft; thence S. 42° 34' E, 157.2 ft; thence N. 84° 59' E, 206.2 ft; thence S. 64° 06' E, 527.0 ft; thence S. 73° 32' E, 432.1 ft; from which point the Southeast corner of Section 20 T. 25-S.
