NARRATIVE-

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO ESTABLISH AND MARK THE NORTH LINES AND TO SET TWO POINTS ON THE SOUTH LINE OF MY CLIENT'S PROPERTY SAID PROPERTY LYING WITHIN THE SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SE 1/4 NE 1/4, NW 1/4 SW 1/4, NE 1/4 SW 1/4, NW 1/4 SE 1/4, AND THE NE 1/4 SE 1/4 OF SECTION 2, T 24 S, R 7 W, W.M. THE CORNER MONUMENTS FOUND AS SHOWN ON THIS SURVEY MAP WERE USED TO DETERMINE THE SUBDIVISION OF SECTION 2. THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER FALLS WITHIN THE UMPQUA RIVER AND WAS POSITIONED BY USING SINGLE PROPORTIONATE MEASUREMENT. THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER WAS POSITIONED BY THE SINGLE PROPORTIONATE METHOD USING THE TOTAL LINEAL DISTANCE ALONG THE NORTH LINE OF SECTION 2 AS SHOWN. THE RECORD DISTANCES USED TO PROPORTION GOVERNMENT LOTS 5, 6, 7, AND 8 WERE 15.65 CH. ALONG THE WEST LINE OF GOVERNMENT LOT 8, SECTION 2, AND 20.00 CH. ALONG THE EAST LINE OF GOVERNMENT LOT 1, SECTION 1 AS PER THE 1858 G.L.O. PLAT MAP IN WHICH THESE LOTS WERE ADDED IN 1861. THIS METHOD CONFORMS TO THE ORIGINAL GOVERNMENT ACREAGE LOTTING. USING THE ABOVE MENTIONED CORNERS, WE SUBDIVIDED SECTION 2 BY THE NORMAL PROCEDURES.
