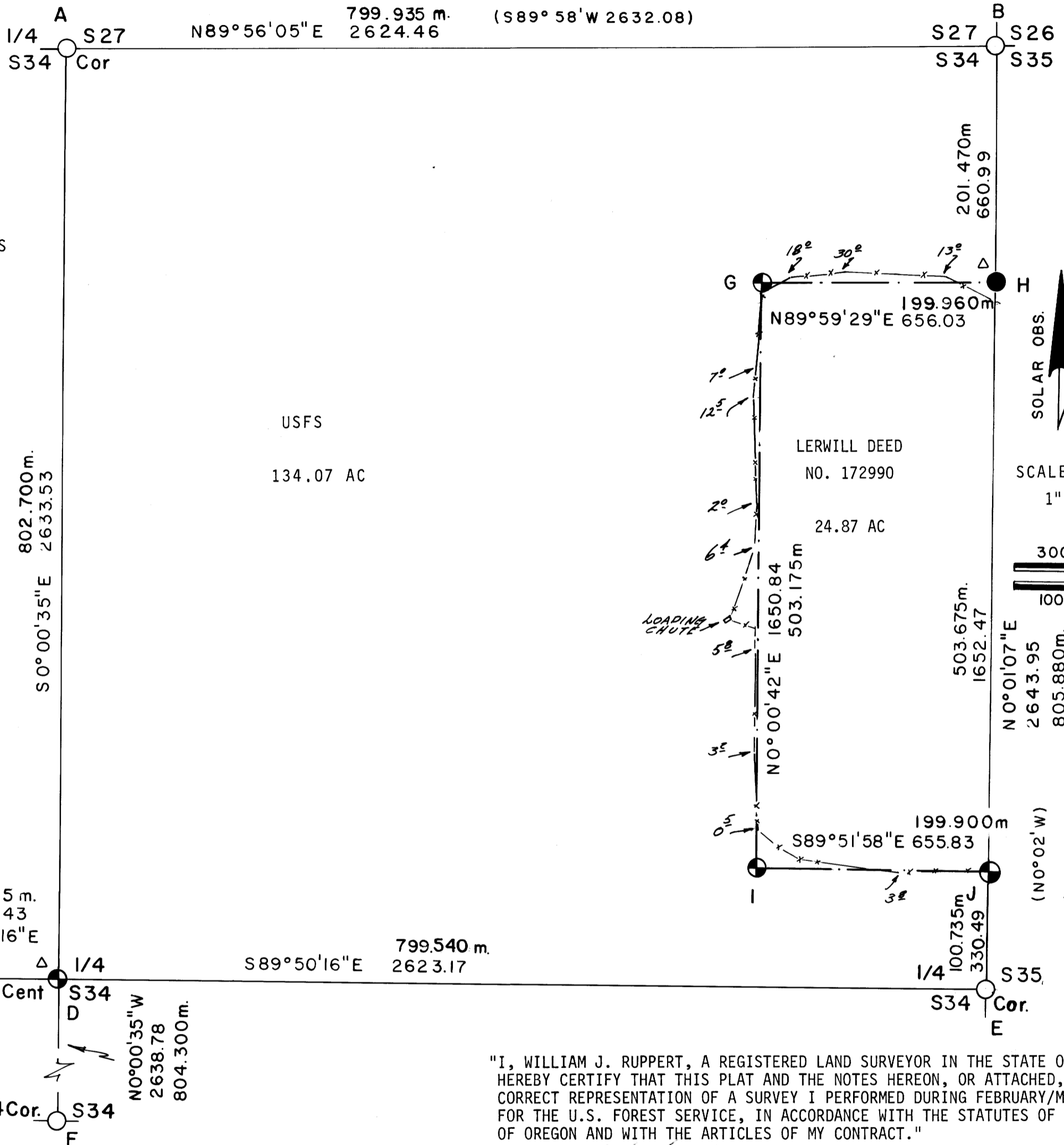

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO ACCOMPANY PLAT OF
SECTION 34, TOWNSHIP 29 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST, WILLAMETTE MERRIDIAN,
FOR USDA FOREST SERVICE, UMPQUA NATIONAL FOREST

PURPOSE: TO SET CORNERS AND POST THE BOUNDARY BETWEEN U.S. FOREST SERVICE
LAND & LAND DESCRIBED IN DEED # 172990.

HISTORY: THE ORIGINAL SURVEY WAS CONDUCTED BY FRED MENSCH, 1910. THE G.L.O.
PLAT WAS APPROVED ON NOVEMBER 11, 1914.

THE SOUTH LINE OF THE TOWNSHIP WAS RESURVEYED IN 1937 BY NORMAN D.
PRICE. REFERENCE TO TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, WAS DELETED FROM THE CORNERS
OF TOWNSHIP 29 SOUTH ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE AT THAT TIME. THE GENERAL
LAND OFFICE PLAT OF OCTOBER 31, 1928 DELINEATES THE PRICE SURVEY.

EQUIPMENT: LEITZ T60D THEODOLITE, MACH II, BEETLE 1000S, AND 100 FT. TAPE.

CORNER ACCESSORIES: ALL BEARING TREES SCRIBED IN THE COURSE OF THIS SURVEY
HAVE A 3/4" BRASS WASHER STAMPED "LS866" NAILED TO THE
LOWER BLAZE.

MEASUREMENTS TO BEARING TREES TAKEN TO THE CENTER OF THE
ROOT CROWN.

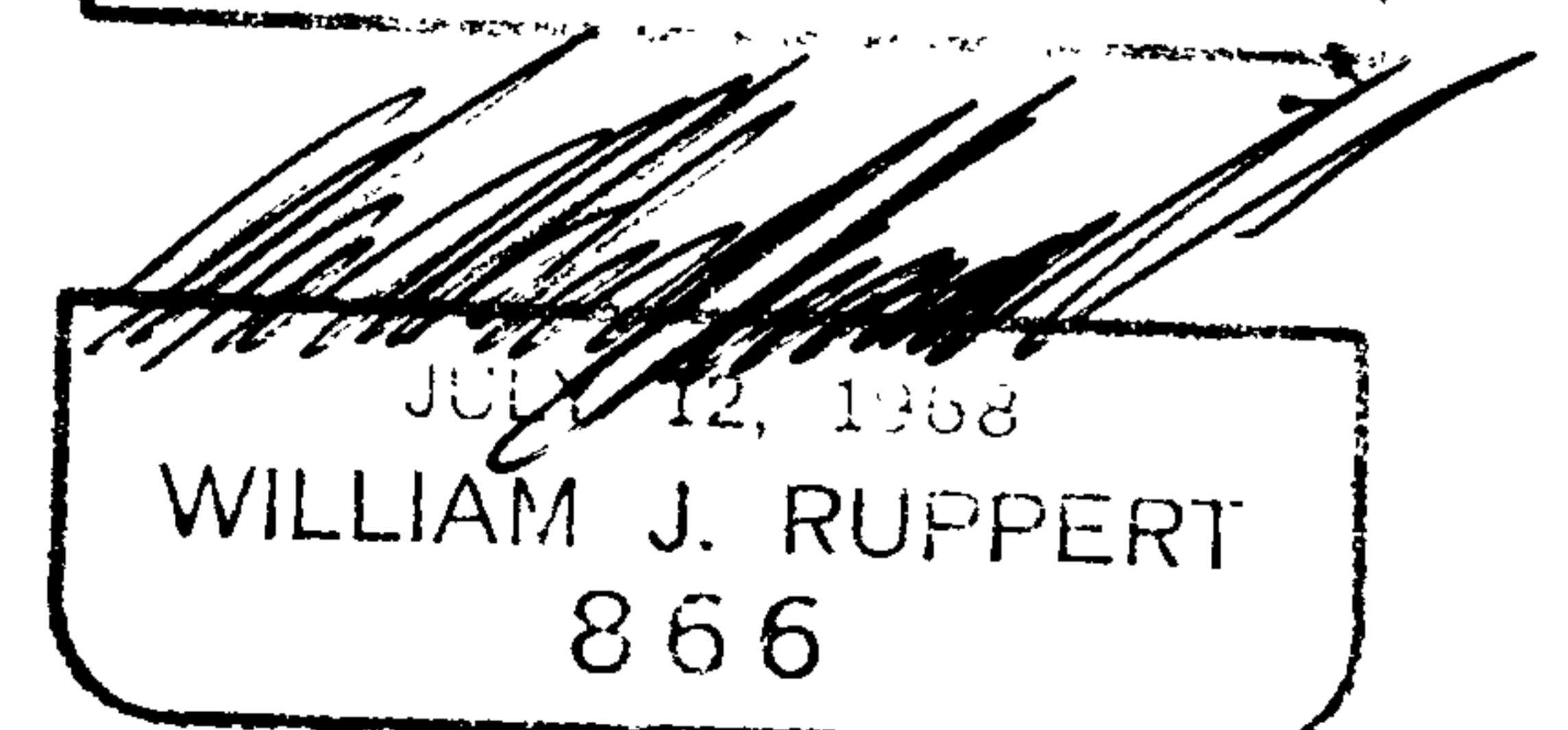
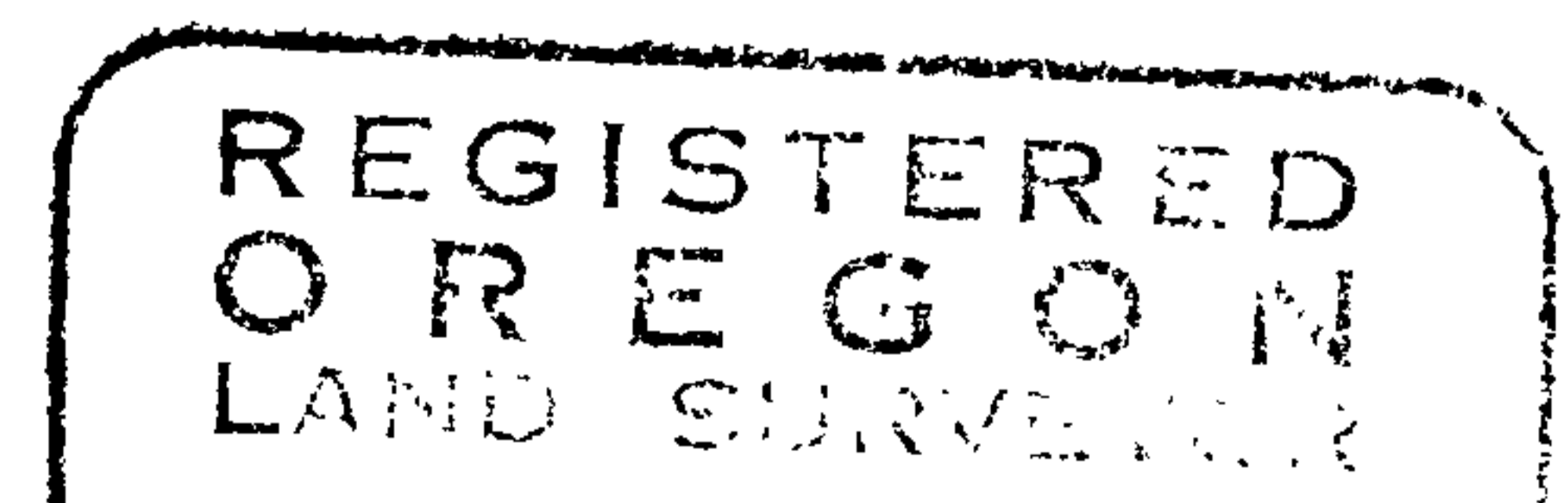

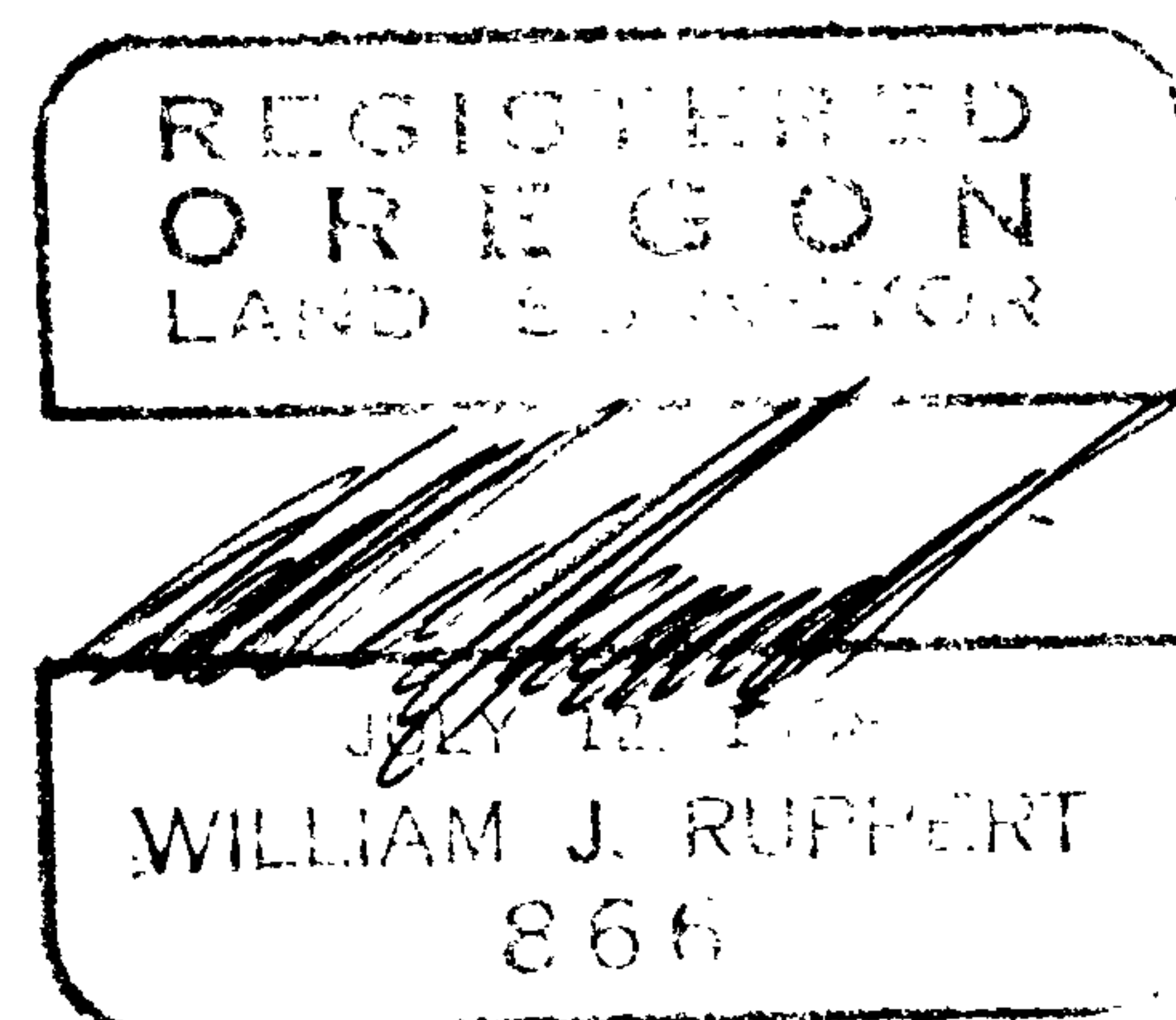

NARRATIVE FOR PLAT OF SURVEY IN
SECTION 34, TOWNSHIP 29 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST,
WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN

A 6" RED BAND, APPROXIMATELY 6" ABOVE UPPER BLAZE, WAS PAINTED AROUND EACH BEARING TREE. THE SCRIBED FACES WERE PAINTED RED. USFS BEARING TREE TAGS 54-3 WERE NAILED ABOVE UPPER BLAZES. USFS SIGNS 54-9 WERE NAILED TO BACK OF ALL TREES PERTAINING TO SET CORNERS. USFS SIGNS 54-4 WERE NAILED TO BACK OF TREES PERTAINING TO FOUND 1/4 AND SECTION CORNERS.
