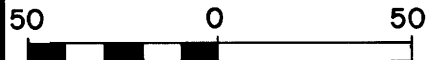

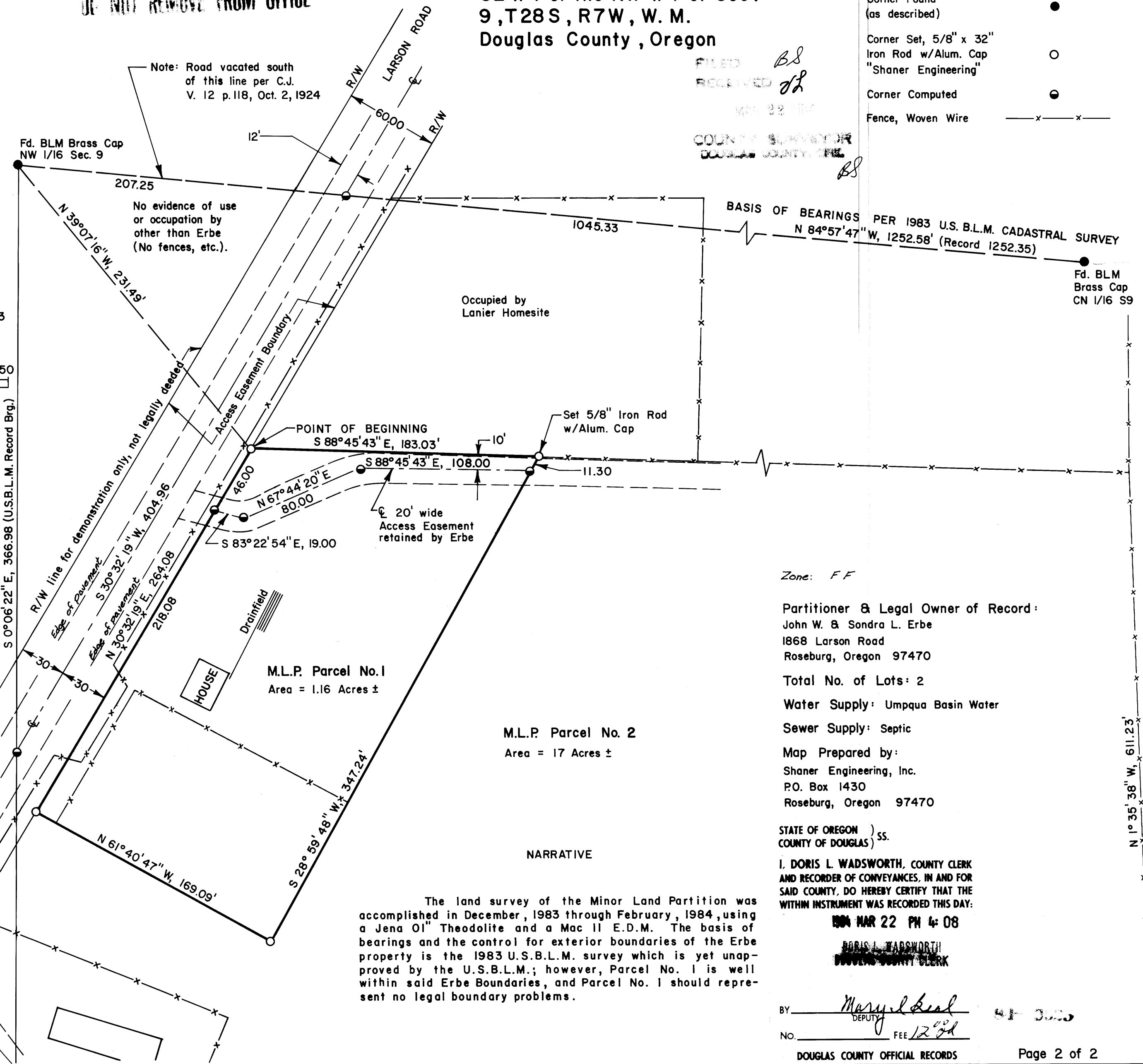

NARRATIVE

The land survey of the Minor Land Partition was accomplished in December, 1983 through February, 1984, using a Jena 01" Theodolite and a Mac II E.D.M. The basis of bearings and the control for exterior boundaries of the Erbe property is the 1983 U.S.B.L.M. survey which is yet unapproved by the U.S.B.L.M.; however, Parcel No. 1 is well within said Erbe Boundaries, and Parcel No. 1 should represent no legal boundary problems.
