The purpose of this survey was to define the boundaries of the James Wood Park No. 2 described in Volume 118, Page 102 of the Douglas County Deed Records.

Basis of bearings was the north-south centerline of Section 9 as shown on the B.L.M. Dependent Resurvey plat dated November 25, 1987.

The west line of the park property would overlap the east line of Tax Lot 600 if located as described in Volume 118, Page 102. I held the east line of Tax Lot 600 as surveyed and monumented on the ground in survey M35-55 as the west line of the park to avoid the overlap. The east line of the park is the north-south centerline of Section 9 as called in the deed. The north line of the park is the current southerly right-of-way line as monumented in the 1963 survey of County Road Number 33. The south line of the park is the right (north) bank of the Umpqua River.

Attached are corner reports showing additional information for the center  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner, south  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner, and special meander corner for Section 9.

Field equipment included a Kern DMK2-AE Theodolite, a Leitz Set-2 Total Station, a Leitz Red-1 Distance Measuring Device, and steel tapes. Field personnel included Randall Smith and Stephen Flause.
