

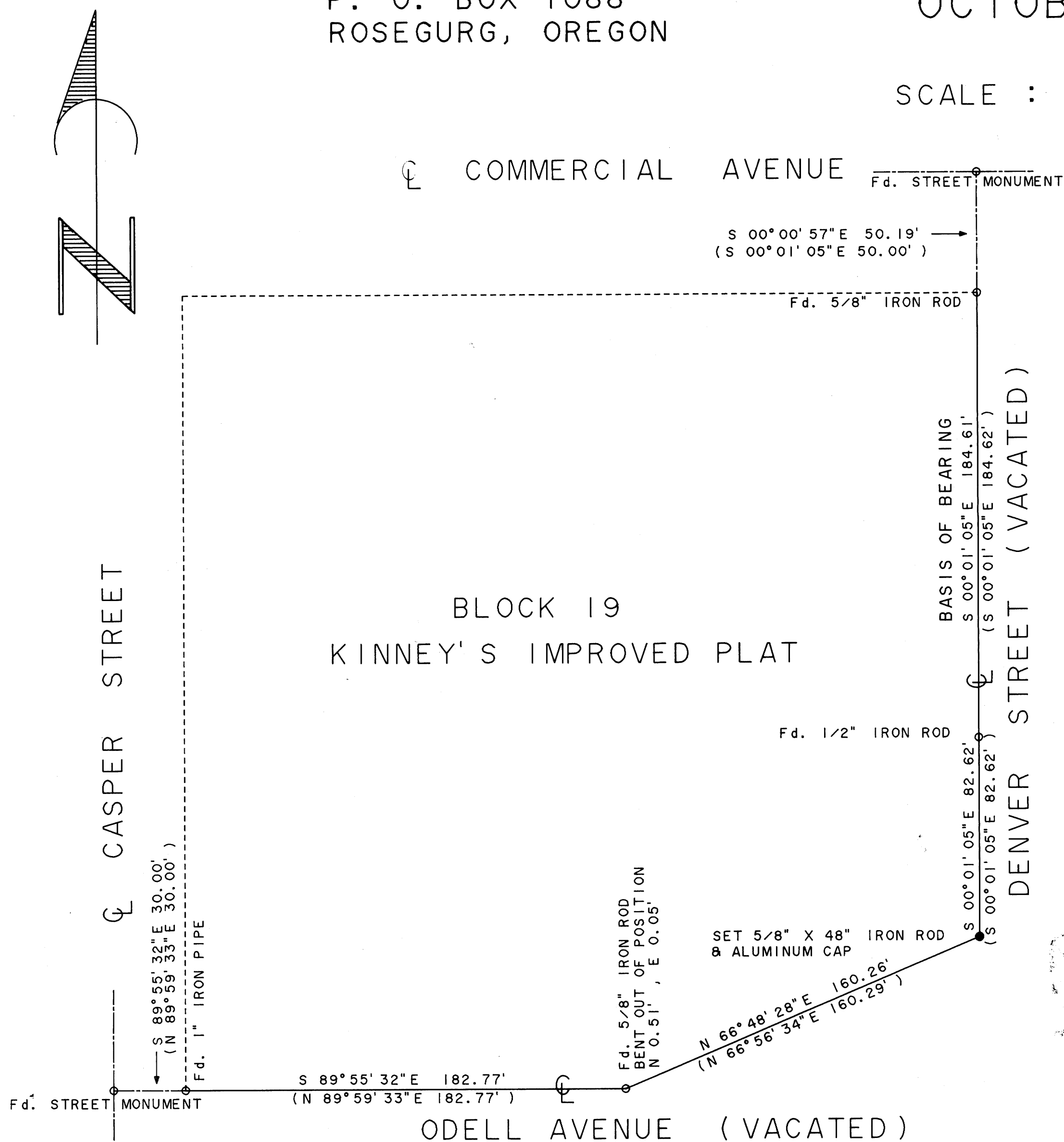

NARRATIVE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO RE-ESTABLISH THE CENTERLINE OF DENVER STREET BETWEEN BLOCKS 18 AND 19 AND THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF PARCEL 3 OF THE MINOR LAND PARTITION IN BLOCK 19 ON THE CENTERLINE OF DENVER STREET, IN KINNEY'S IMPROVED PLAT, IN SECTION 18, TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN.

THE CONTROL FOR THIS SURVEY WAS THE MINOR LAND PARTITION SURVEY PERFORMED BY GLENN BAUGHMAN IN 1976 AND RECORDED ON M 62-9.

THE BASIS OF BEARING WAS THE CENTERLINE OF DENVER STREET BETWEEN BLOCKS 18 AND 19 AS SHOWN ON M 62-9.

THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED IN SEPTEMBER, 1990 USING A NIKON NTD-4 TOTAL STATION TO RUN A CLOSED LOOP TRAVERSE WITH A PRECISION OF 1 : 279,521. I ADJUSTED THE TRAVERSE BY THE TRANSIT METHOD.
