NARRATIVE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO RE-ESTABLISH THE SECTION CORNER COMMON TO SECTIONS 2 AND 3, T. 26 S., R. 6 W., AND SECTIONS 34 AND 35, T. 25 S., R. 6 W., W.M., DOUGLAS COUNTY, OREGON.

THE BASIS OF BEARING IS THE TOWNSHIP LINE BETWEEN THE N 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 2 AND THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 3, T. 26 S., R. 6 W., W. M. AS SURVEYED BY ELDER AND GILE IN 1853.

NO EVIDENCE OF THE ORIGINAL SECTION CORNER WAS FOUND AND THE CORNER WAS RE-ESTABLISHED BY SINGLE PROPORTIONATE METHOD BETWEEN THE N 1/4 OF SECTION 2 AS RENEWED BY THE COUNTY SURVEYOR IN 1963 (CS49/123) AND THE N 1/4 OF SECTION 3 AS RE-ESTABLISHED BY A. R. EVANS IN 1949 (CS43-167,M16-25), BOTH FOUND AS NOTED.

THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED IN FEBRUARY AND MARCH 1993 USING A TOPCON GTS-302 TOTAL STATION TO RUN A CLOSED LOOP TRAVERSE.
