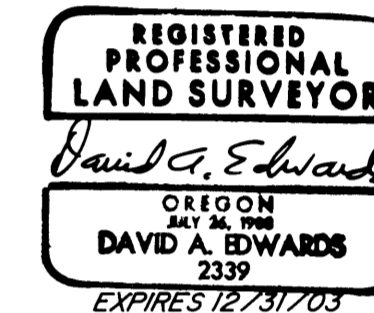

## NARRATIVE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY IS TO POST, BLAZE AND FLAG THE WEST LINE OF THE SW 1/4 OF THE NE 1/4, TO POST, BLAZE AND FLAG A PORTION OF THE EAST LINES OF THE NW AND SW 1/4'S OF SAID NE 1/4, TO SET THE CN 1/16 AND NE 1/16 CORNERS OF SECTION II AS WELL AS TO FLAG THE REMAINING BOUNDARIES OF THE MCGLAUGHLIN TRACT AS SHOWN HEREON. UTILIZING EXISTING CONTROL POINTS AND DATA ESTABLISHED BY THIS OFFICE DURING THE EXECUTION OF C.S. 65/29-6, I TIE IN THE NECESSARY ADDITIONAL CONTROLLING MONUMENTS AND COMPUTE THE SUBDIVISION OF THE NE 1/4 AS SHOWN. THE FOUND 2" PIPE AND 3/4" REBAR WERE HELD FOR NORTH-SOUTH POSITION WITH THE 2" PIPE BEING HELD AS THE SE CORNER OF DOC. NO. 2003-006320. THE NORTHERLY PORTION OF THE WEST LINE OF MCGLAUGHLIN WAS FLAGGED ALONG THE EXISTING FENCE, WHICH APPROXIMATES THE LINE SURVEYED ON C.S. 42/290 AND TO WHICH THE WESTERLY ADJOINER HAS RECENTLY LOGGED.

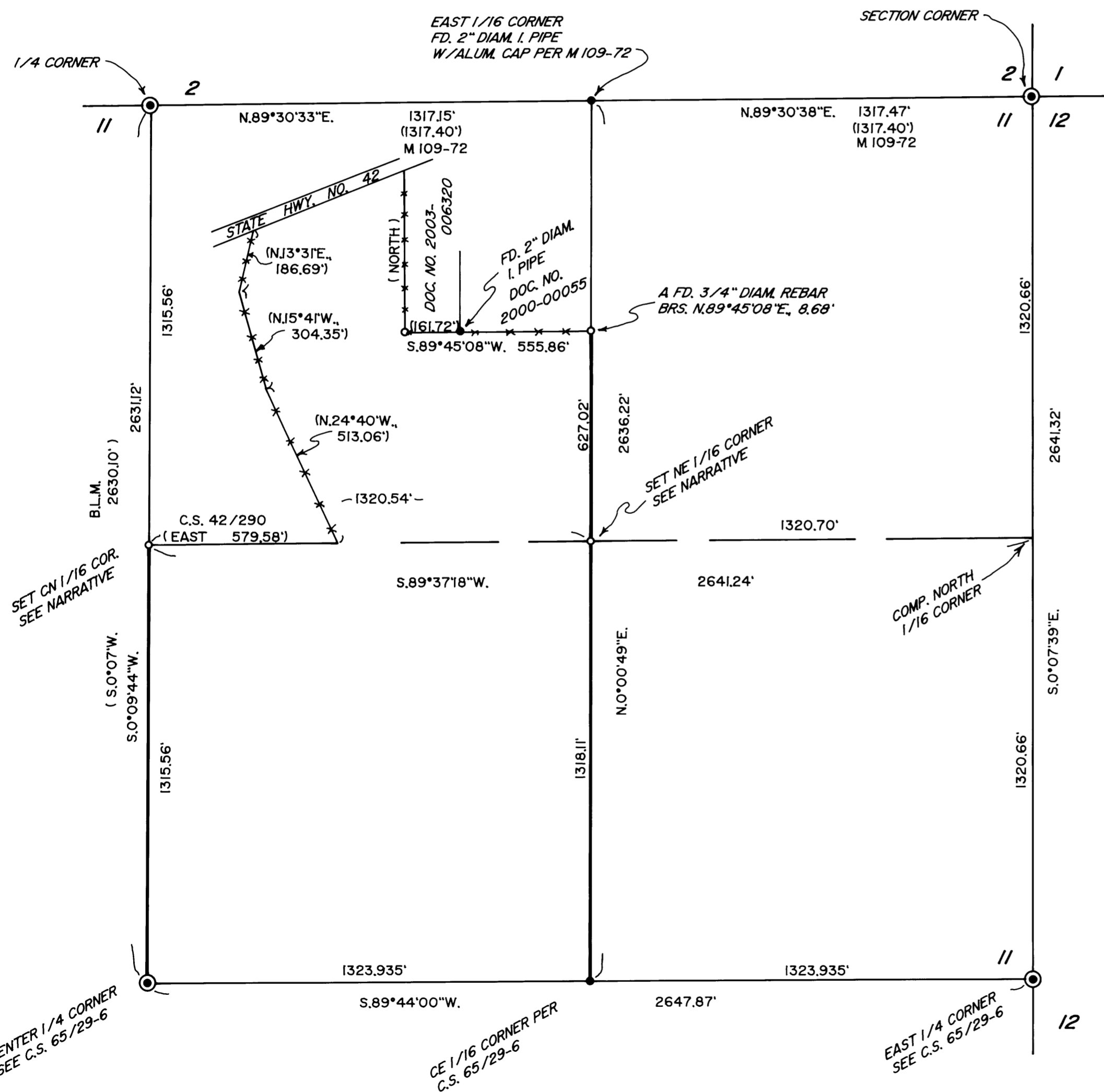

 8" DIAM. FIR BEARS N.63°W., 3.9 FEET.

AT THE NE 1/16 CORNER: 7" FIR BEARS N.18°E., 14.5 FEET. BOTH SCRIBED "NE 1/16 SII BT"  
 5" FIR BEARS S.53°E., 21.0 FEET.
