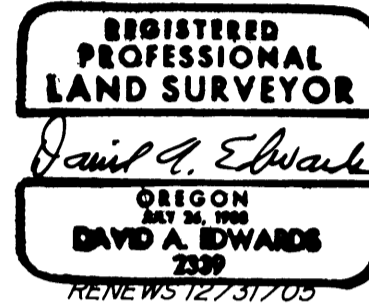

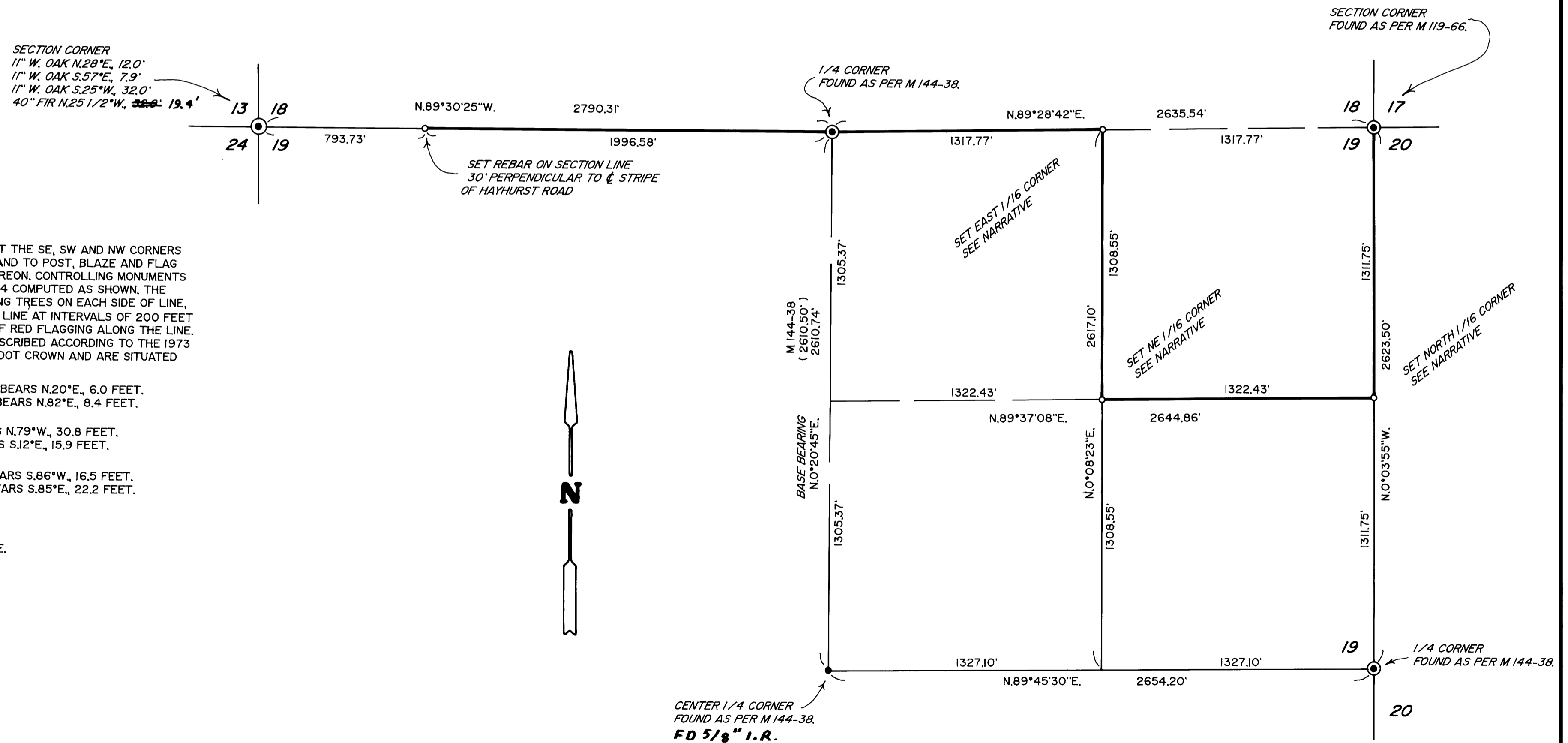

### NARRATIVE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY IS TO MONUMENT THE SE, SW AND NW CORNERS OF THE NE 1/4 OF THE NE 1/4 OF SECTION 19 AND TO POST, BLAZE AND FLAG THOSE BOUNDARIES SHOWN AS A BOLD LINE HEREON. CONTROLLING MONUMENTS WERE TIED AND THE SUBDIVISION OF THE NE 1/4 COMPUTED AS SHOWN. THE SUBJECT BOUNDARIES WERE MARKED BY BLAZING TREES ON EACH SIDE OF LINE, BY SETTING 6 FOOT STEEL POSTS ALONG TRUE LINE AT INTERVALS OF 200 FEET OR LESS AND BY HANGING LIBERAL AMOUNTS OF RED FLAGGING ALONG THE LINE. BEARING TREES MARKED ON THIS SURVEY ARE SCRIBED ACCORDING TO THE 1973 MANUAL, MEASURED TO CENTER OF TREE AT ROOT CROWN AND ARE SITUATED AS FOLLOWS:

AT THE EAST 1/16 CORNER: AN 8" DIAM. CEDAR BEARS N.20°E., 6.0 FEET.  
A 12" DIAM. CEDAR BEARS N.82°E., 8.4 FEET.

AT THE NE 1/16 CORNER: A 10" DIAM. FIR BEARS N.79°W., 30.8 FEET.  
A 26" DIAM. FIR BEARS S.12°E., 15.9 FEET.

AT THE NORTH 1/16 CORNER: A 14" DIAM. FIR BEARS S.86°W., 16.5 FEET.  
AN 11" DIAM. FIR BEARS S.85°E., 22.2 FEET.
