

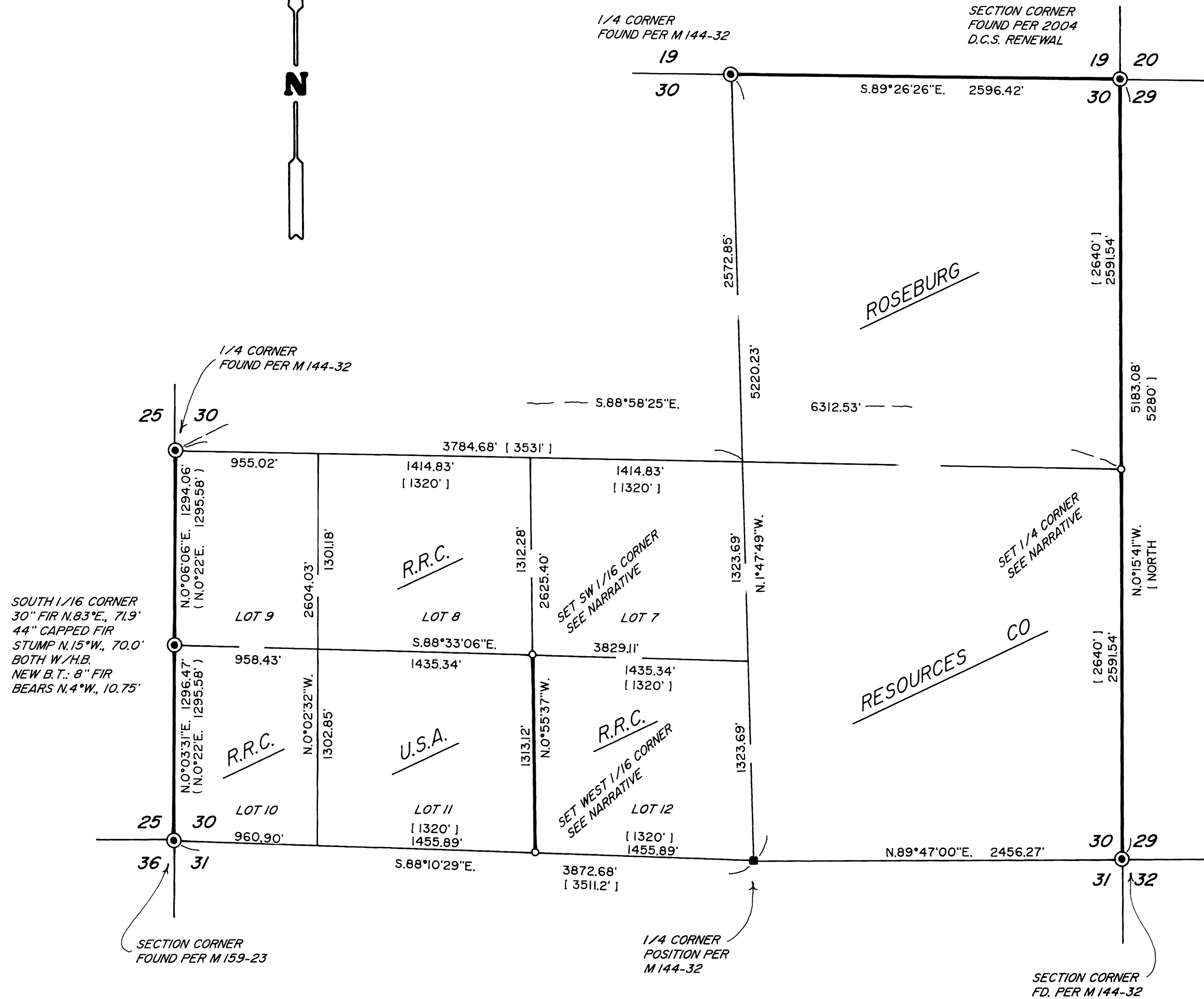
MAP OF SURVEY

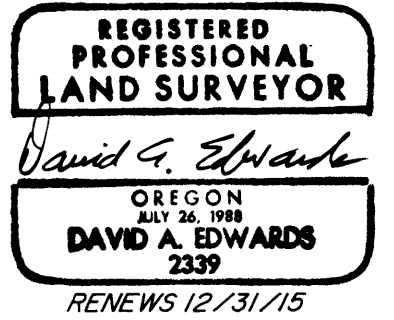

NARRATIVE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY IS TO SET THREE PROPERTY CORNERS AND MARK CERTAIN PORTIONS OF ROSEBURG RESOURCES LAND IN SECTION 30. EXISTING CONTROL POINTS AND DATA BY THIS OFFICE ON SURVEY M 144-32 AS WELL AS TIES TO THE SW CORNER AND SOUTH 1/16 CORNER WERE USED TO CONTROL THIS SURVEY. THE PROPORTIONING OF THE SW 1/4 OF THE SECTION INTO THE GOVERNMENT LOTS WAS COMPUTED ACCORDING TO THE 2009 B.L.M. MANUAL. THE SUBJECT BOUNDARIES WERE MARKED BY BLAZING TREES ON EACH SIDE OF LINE, BY SETTING 6 FOOT STEEL POSTS ALONG THE LINES AT INTERVALS OF 200 FEET OR LESS AND BY HANGING LIBERAL AMOUNTS OF RED FLAGGING ALONG THE TRUE BOUNDARY. BEARING TREES WERE SCRIBED ACCORDING TO SAID MANUAL, MEASURED TO CENTER OF TREE AT ROOT CROWN AND ARE SITUATED AS FOLLOWS:

AT THE SET 1/4 CORNER COMMON TO SECTIONS 29 AND 30:

- A FOUND 18" DIAM. FIR W/HEALED BLAZE FROM 1983
- B.L.M. ADMINISTRATIVE SURVEY BEARS S.29°W., 26.5 FEET.
- A 6" DIAM. LIVE OAK BEARS S.54°E., 17.95 FEET.
- A 14" DIAM. LIVE OAK BEARS S.5°W., 22.95 FEET.
- A 6 FOOT STEEL POST IS SET 2 FEET NORTH.

AT THE SOUTHWEST 1/16 CORNER OF SECTION 30:

- A 9" DIAM. FIR BEARS S.22°E., 15.60 FEET.
- AN 8" DIAM. FIR BEARS S.88°W., 27.00 FEET.
- A 6 FOOT STEEL POST IS SET 2 FEET SOUTH.

AT THE WEST 1/16 CORNER COMMON TO SECTIONS 30 AND 31:

- A FOUND 12" DIAM. FIR W/HEALED BLAZE FROM 1983
- B.L.M. ADMINISTRATIVE SURVEY BEARS S.35°E., 28.1 FEET.
- A 5" DIAM. FIR BEARS N.78°W., 30.9 FEET.
- A 6 FOOT STEEL POST IS SET 2 FEET NORTH.
