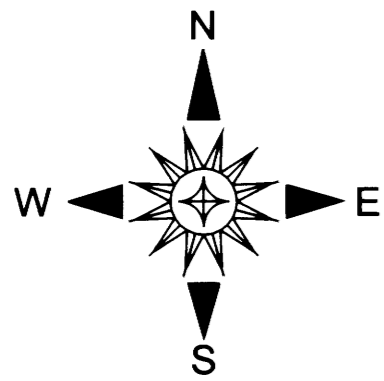


MAP OF SURVEY

in Douglas County, Oregon.

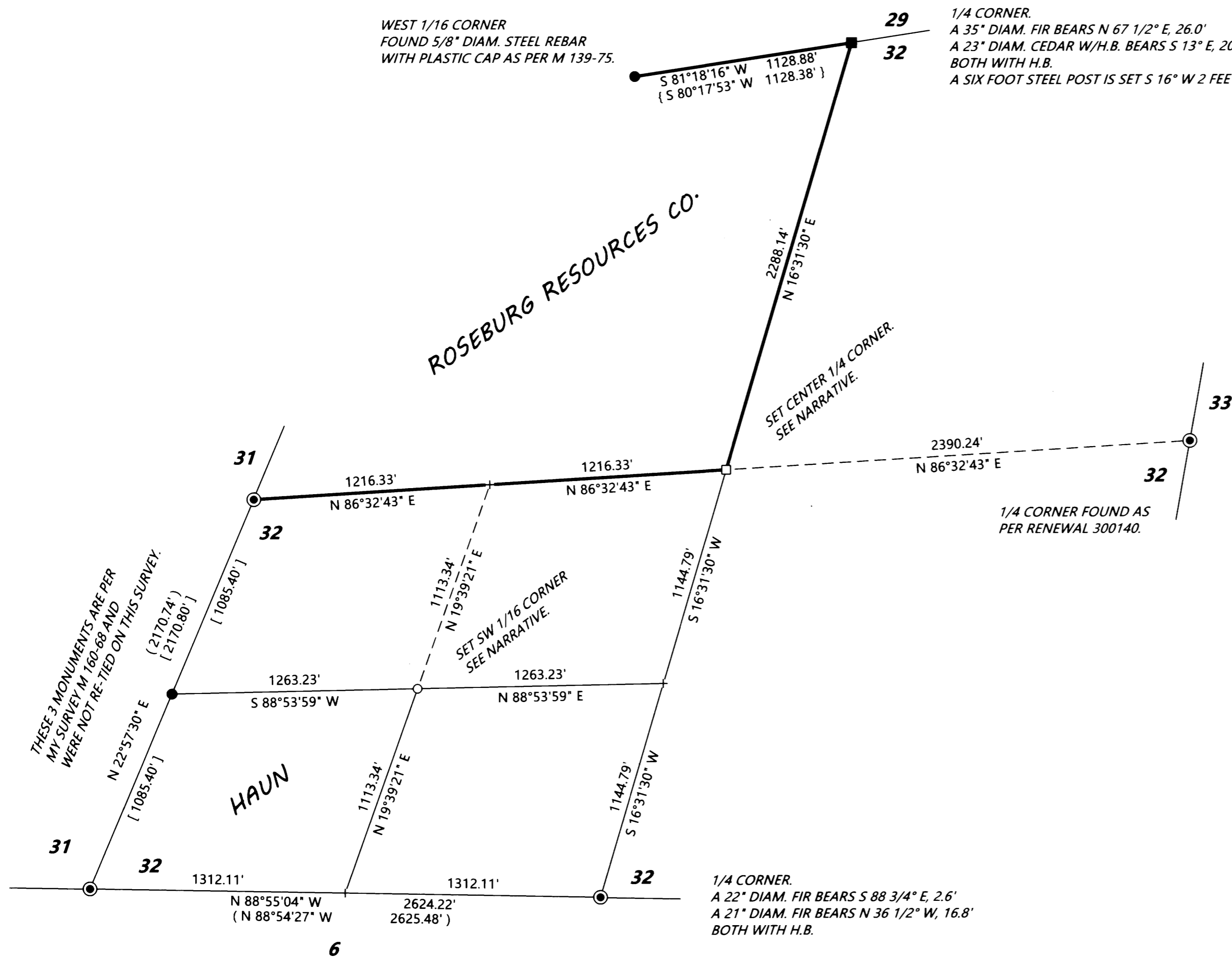

NARRATIVE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY IS TO MARK THOSE BOUNDARIES SHOWN HEREON AS BOLD LINES. UTILIZING EXISTING CONTROL POINTS AND DATA PER SURVEY M 160-68 BY THIS OFFICE, TRAVERSES WERE RUN THAT TIED IN ADDITIONAL MONUMENTS NECESSARY TO SUBDIVIDE THE SECTION AS SHOWN. TRAVERSES WERE THEN RUN ALONG THE DESIRED BOUNDARIES AND OFFSETS MADE TO THE TRUE LINE. THE LINES WERE MARKED BY BLAZING TREES ON EACH SIDE OF LINE, BY SETTING SIX FOOT STEEL POSTS ALONG THE BOUNDARIES AT INTERVALS OF 200 FEET OR LESS AND BY HANGING LIBERAL AMOUNTS OF RED FLAGGING ALONG THE TRUE LINE. RECORD DATA PER MY SURVEY M 160-68 WAS USED FOR THE POSITIONS OF MONUMENTS ON THE WEST LINE OF THE SW 1/4.

AT THE SET CENTER 1/4 CORNER: A 10" DIAM. MADRONE BEARS N 52° E, 44.2'
A 23" DIAM. CEDAR BEARS S 14° E, 25.3'
AN 8" DIAM. CEDAR BEARS S 65° W, 10.2'
A SIX FOOT STEEL POST IS SET N 16° E, 2 FEET. ALL SCRIBED "C 1/4 S32 BT"

AT THE SET SW 1/16 CORNER: CORNER FALLS ON EDGE OF DIRT ROAD.
NO BEARING TREES AVAILABLE.
SET 6 FOOT STEEL POSTS 3 FEET S 89° W AND ALONGSIDE MONUMENT.
