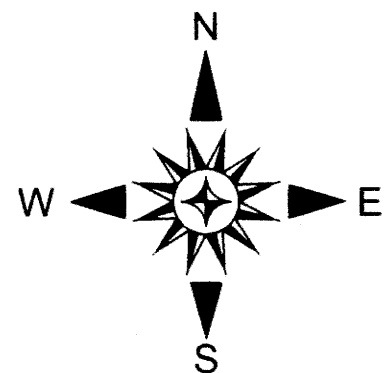

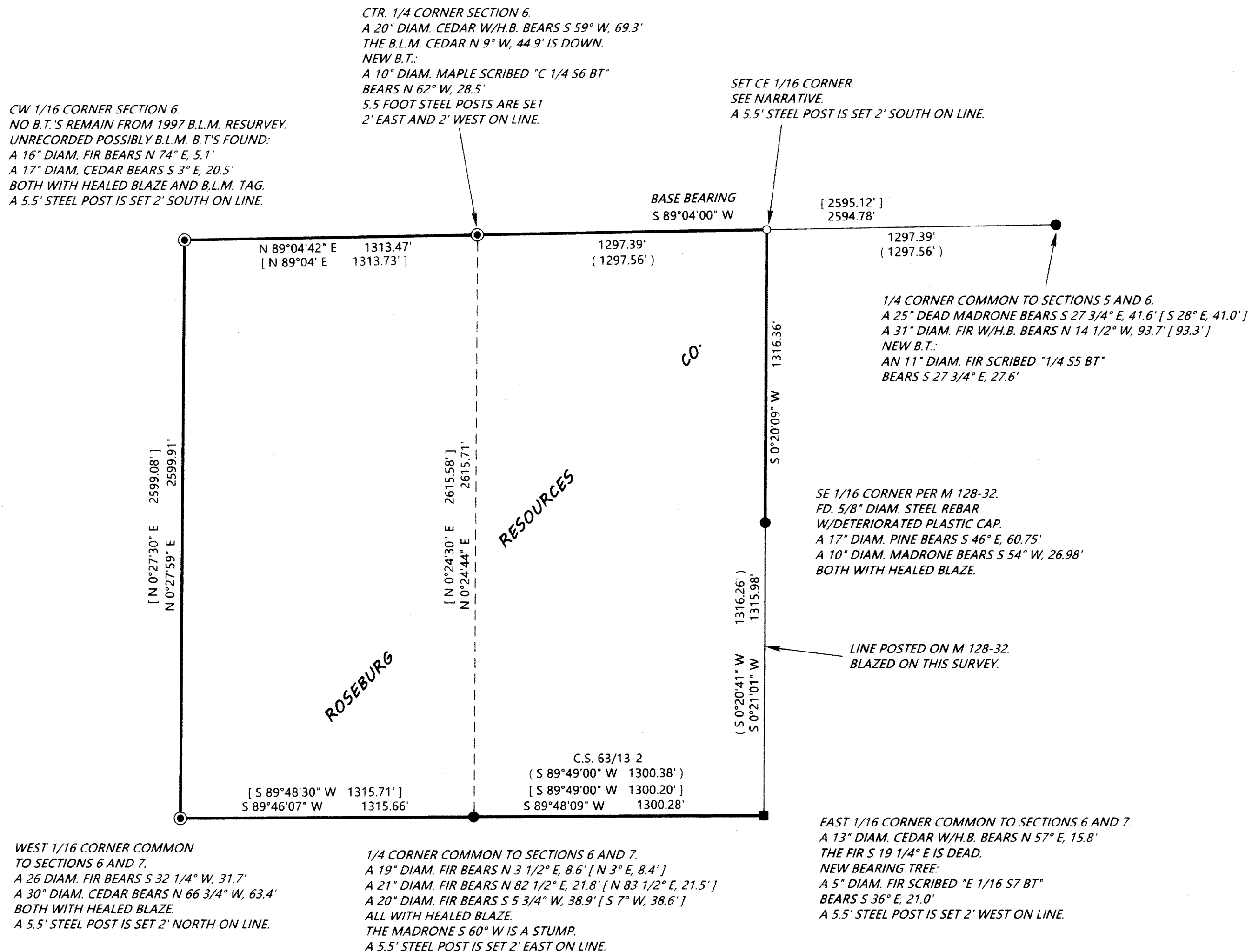

NARRATIVE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY IS TO POST AND BLAZE THOSE BOUNDARIES DEPICTED AS BOLD LINES HEREON. RANDOM TRAVERSES WERE RUN NEAR THE DESIRED BOUNDARIES AND OFFSETS MADE TO THE TRUE LINE. AN ADDITIONAL CONTROL TIE WAS MADE TO THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6. THE BOUNDARIES WERE MARKED BY BLAZING TREES ON EACH SIDE OF LINE, BY SETTING 5.5 FOOT STEEL POSTS ALONG THE BOUNDARY AT INTERVALS OF 200 FEET OR LESS AND BY HANGING LIBERAL AMOUNTS OF RED FLAGGING ALONG THE TRUE BOUNDARY.

AT THE SET CE 1/16 CORNER: A 12" DIAM. FIR BEARS S 43° E, 11.7'
AN 11" DIAM. FIR BEARS S 8° W, 25.1' BOTH SCRIBED "CE 1/16 S6 BT"
