IT IS NOTED THAT DISCREPANCIES
APPEAR IN BOTH BEARINGS AND

DISTANCES WHEN ATTEMPTING TO
DETERMINE THE TRUE CORNER POSITION
USING THE 60" MAPLE IN CONJUNCTION
WITH THE TWO 16" MAPLES. HOLDING
THE DISTANCE FROM THE 60" MAPLE
CAUSES THE BEARINGS AND DISTANCES
FROM THE REMAINING BT'S TO BE IN
ERROR.

AT THE TRUE CORNER POINT;
SET A $\frac{5}{8}$ " $\times$ 30" IRON ROD, BURIED
18" BELOW GROUND SURFACE IN A
GARDEN AREA. NO TRACE OF RIFLE BARREL
OR ANGLE IRON WAS FOUND.
