rhododendron, and salal.

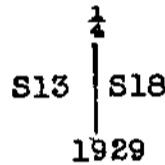
North bet. secs. 13 and 18.

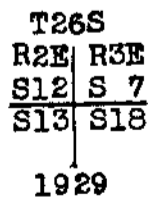
A pine, 16 ins. diam., bears N.64\*W., 107 lks.

the ground, for cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13, and 18, with  
brass cap mkd.
